



SpraBo (*Sprachkompetenz und Berufsorientierung* = language proficiency and vocational orientation) is available for refugees interested in nursing. We provide insights into the role of nurses, explore the structure of the German health care system and how people in need are cared for here. We also want to highlight the various career options that exist in nursing. During the project, we accompany you during your first contact with practitioners and your first nursing experiences. You learn about the differences between outpatient, inpatient and day-care areas. We provide opportunities to reflect upon your experiences, and to explore throughout the project which prerequisites you already bring along to become a nurse. Our goal is to assist you with decisions about further formal nursing education and training options. At the centre of the Sprabo project is the further development of your current knowledge of the German language. So we focus on your existing language skills and want to help you to improve these. We do this by providing daily German language lessons but also by you becoming acquainted with some healthcare-specific expressions during your vocational orientation.

At the end of the course, you will have the opportunity to acquire a language certificate at the next higher level. The main prerequisite to participate in a Sprabo course is your interest in the nursing profession. Previous care experiences, for example within your family or in the country you came from, might be valuable because they will facilitate our discussion about some particularities of the German health care system. It would be helpful if you have already achieved a German language level of at least A2 or you are working towards achieving this goal. The advancement and support of women is our priority and thus, we would provide childcare if this is needed. contains 3 hours of German language instruction and 3 hours of practical vocational orientation. The language lessons take place at the Health Academy of the Charité and the practical classes take place at different locations of the Vivantes Network for Health GmbH or the Virchow Clinic of the Charité.

The Sprabo course normally takes 6 months. Our course days are from Monday to Friday. Each day contains 3 hours of German language instruction and 3 hours of practical vocational orientation. The language lessons take place at the Health Academy of the Charité and the practical classes take place at different locations of the Vivantes Network for Health GmbH or the Virchow Clinic of the Charité.
